**PROPOSED ISSUE OF S\$200,000,000 2.80 PER CENT. NOTES DUE 2033 UNDER THE
S\$3,000,000,000 MULTICURRENCY DEBT ISSUANCE PROGRAMME (THE “PROGRAMME”)**

Keppel Infrastructure Fund Management Pte. Ltd. (in its capacity as trustee-manager of Keppel Infrastructure Trust (“KIT”, together with its subsidiaries, the “Group”)) (the “Issuer” or “Trustee-Manager”) wishes to announce that pursuant to a subscription agreement dated 21 April 2026 entered into between (1) the Issuer, as issuer and (2) DBS Bank Ltd., Oversea-Chinese Banking Corporation Limited and (3) United Overseas Bank Limited as joint lead managers (the “Joint Lead Managers”), the Issuer proposes to issue S\$200,000,000 2.80 per cent. notes due 2033 pursuant to the Programme (the “Series 006 Notes”).

Unless otherwise defined herein, terms used in this Announcement shall bear the same meanings ascribed to them in the Information Memorandum dated 20 April 2026 and the pricing supplement for the Series 006 Notes dated 21 April 2026 (the “Pricing Supplement”).

The principal terms of the Series 006 Notes will be as follows:

- (a) **Issue Size** : S\$200,000,000
- (b) **Issue Price** : 100 per cent. of the principal amount of the Series 006 Notes.
- (c) **Status of the Notes** : The Series 006 Notes constitute direct, unconditional, unsubordinated and unsecured obligations of the Issuer and shall at all times rank pari passu, and rateably without any preference or priority among themselves and pari passu with all other present and future unsecured obligations (other than subordinated obligations and priorities created by law) of the Issuer, from time to time outstanding.
- (d) **Maturity Date** : 28 April 2033

- (e) **Interest Rate** : 2.80 per cent. per annum, payable semi-annually in arrear on 28 April and 28 October of each year. The first Interest Payment Date will fall on 28 October 2026.
- (f) **Redemption** : The Series 006 Notes may be redeemed upon the occurrence of certain redemption events specified in the Pricing Supplement.
- (g) **Redemption Price** : 100 per cent. of the principal amount of the Series 006 Notes then outstanding, together with any accrued interest.

The Series 006 Notes are expected to be issued on 28 April 2026.

The Series 006 Notes are offered only to (i) institutional investors (as defined in Section 4A of the Securities and Futures Act 2001 of Singapore (the “SFA”)) pursuant to Section 274 of the SFA, or (ii) accredited investors (as defined in Section 4A of the SFA) pursuant to and in accordance with the conditions specified in Section 275 of the SFA and (where applicable) Regulation 3 of the Securities and Futures (Classes of Investors) Regulations 2018 of Singapore.

Application will be made to the Singapore Exchange Securities Trading Limited (the “SGX-ST”) for permission to deal in the listing and quotation of the Series 006 Notes on the SGX-ST. Admission to the Official List of the SGX-ST and the listing and quotation of the Series 006 Notes on the SGX-ST is not to be taken as an indication of the merits of the Trustee-Manager, KIT, their respective subsidiaries (if any) and associates (if any), the Programme or the Series 006 Notes.

The net proceeds arising from the issue of the Series 006 Notes, after the deduction of issue expenses, will be used by the Issuer towards (a) financing or refinancing acquisitions and/or investments of the Group and any asset enhancement works of the Group, (b) financing the general working capital purposes and/or capital expenditure requirements of the Group, or (c) refinancing the borrowings of the Group.

The Series 006 Notes contain a condition where a default may occur if the Trustee-Manager resigns, retires, ceases to be or is removed or is unable to continue to act as the trustee-manager of KIT, and the replacement or substitute trustee-manager is not appointed in accordance with the terms of the trust deed constituting KIT and/or in accordance with the applicable law. If the condition is breached, it may trigger cross defaults in the other facilities, debt issues and borrowings of KIT and/or its subsidiaries. In such an event, the aggregate level of facilities, debt issues and borrowings that may be affected is approximately S\$1.63 billion (including the Series 006 Notes but excluding interest and fees) as at the present date. As at the date of this announcement, there has not been a breach of the condition described above.
